Comedian Andrew Dice Clay Brings His Outrageous Stand Up Act to FireLake Grand Casino

In 1989, following the release of his debut comedy album *Dice*, he appeared on the MTV Video Music Awards with his stand-up routine. His vulgar, profane material caused uproar from groups around the country and prompted MTV to ban him from the network for life. Controversy continued to swell around Clay and while he continued to release comedy albums and appear in films and TV shows, his image was tarnished and his audience scarce.

After stepping back and spending several years out of the media's eye, Clay began his comeback in 2006 when he signed a deal with Sirius Radio to produce and broadcast his own show, *Out of the Cage*. In March 2007, he premiered a weekly reality show on VH1 called *Dice: Undisputed*. The show

follows Clay through his personal and professional trials as he fights to get back to the top of the comedy world.

“Edgy and often controversial, Andrew Dice Clay puts on a show that is unlike any other. His refusal to follow the rules only heightens his ability to entertain and appall all at the same time.
