COUNTRY MUSIC SWEETHEART, TANYA TUCKER, COMES TO FIRELAKE GRAND CASINO

SHAWNEE, Okla., August 5, 2007—One of country music's most prolific female vocalists, Tanya Tucker, will have audiences on their feet singing along to some of country's most notable songs when she takes the stage at FireLake Grand Casino in Shawnee, Okla. on August 9 at 7 p.m.

Big things were in the stars for the Seminole, Texas native when she made her entrance into country music at just 13 years old. Shortly after being signed to Columbia Records by producer Bill Sherrill, Tucker's first single, "Delta Dawn" was released and shot up the country music charts. She was, from that moment on, unstoppable.

Tucker has spent 35 years working in country music, though she has not yet reached 50 years of age. In that time she has released an impressive 27 albums featuring 40 Top Ten country singles, 11 of which reached Number 1. She was named Academy of Country Music's "Top New Female Vocalist," Country Music Association's "Female Vocalist of the Year" in 1991, received a Grammy nomination for "Delta Dawn," and was inducted into the Texas Music Hall of Fame in 2003.

Though "Delta Dawn" put her in the spotlight, a healthy catalog of countless hits would keep her there. Among those are staples like "Love's the Answer," "Texas (When I Die)," "Just Another Love," "Down to My Last

Teardrop,” and “Two Sparrows in a Hurricane,” which was named Academy of Country Music’s Video of the Year in 1991.

“Tanya Tucker is a true county music icon. Her exceptional talent, persistence and dedication to her craft have made her the success she continues to be. We are excited to welcome Ms. Tucker to our casino and look forward to a fantastic show,” said Brad Peltier, Director of Marketing and Public Relations.
